3. Raise public awareness on different social issues through project execution and advocacy.


About University & College YMCA Department

Requirement of Service Project	Pandemic Supports	Provide supports and answer needs under the COVID-19 pandemic situation. Enhance participants' understanding and awareness of local issues and encourage them to serve the underprivileged. Raise public awareness through promotion and advocacy.	
	Mental Health	Provide activities/means for tertiary students to relax physically and mentally, enhance their understanding and awareness of mental health issues. Build a positive and supportive societal and campus culture on mental health.
